Step One: Survey : Look at pictures, captions, bold words, titles, etc to get an idea of what you will be reading about.		



Step Two – Question: Based on what you surveyed, ask questions that you would like to have answered during your reading. These cannot be Yes/No type questions. Number your questions!

Step Three – Read: read the material with your brain. **Think** about what you are reading and read for comprehension. In the space below and on the back of this page, **write notes** over the material you are reading. Write all **bold** words, etc. – vocabulary and concepts, and *write their definitions*. Write examples that explain the terms and concepts, draw pictures, etc. . .

Step Four – Recite: Without looking at your notes, **review the information you just read**. You may do this in your mind, you may write or draw it out on paper, or you may say it out loud.
